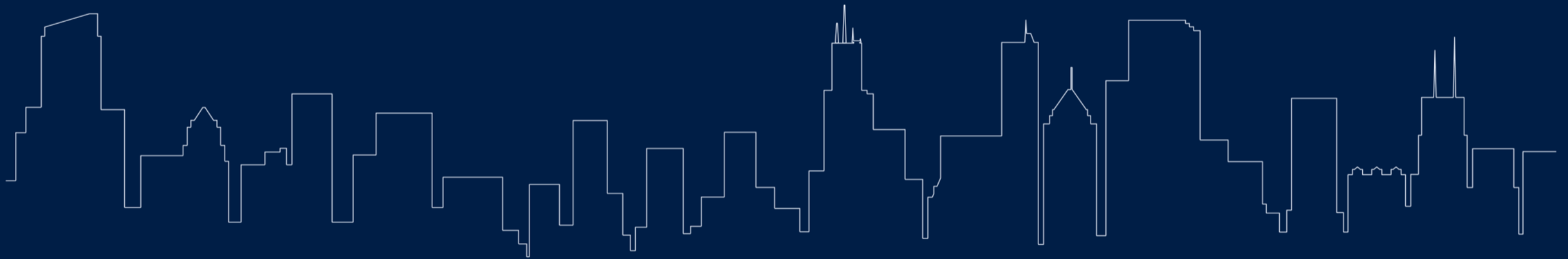

- Where has violent crime been happening?
- When is crime happening?
- What are the demographics of the victims?
- Which areas of the city have the highest rates of violence?

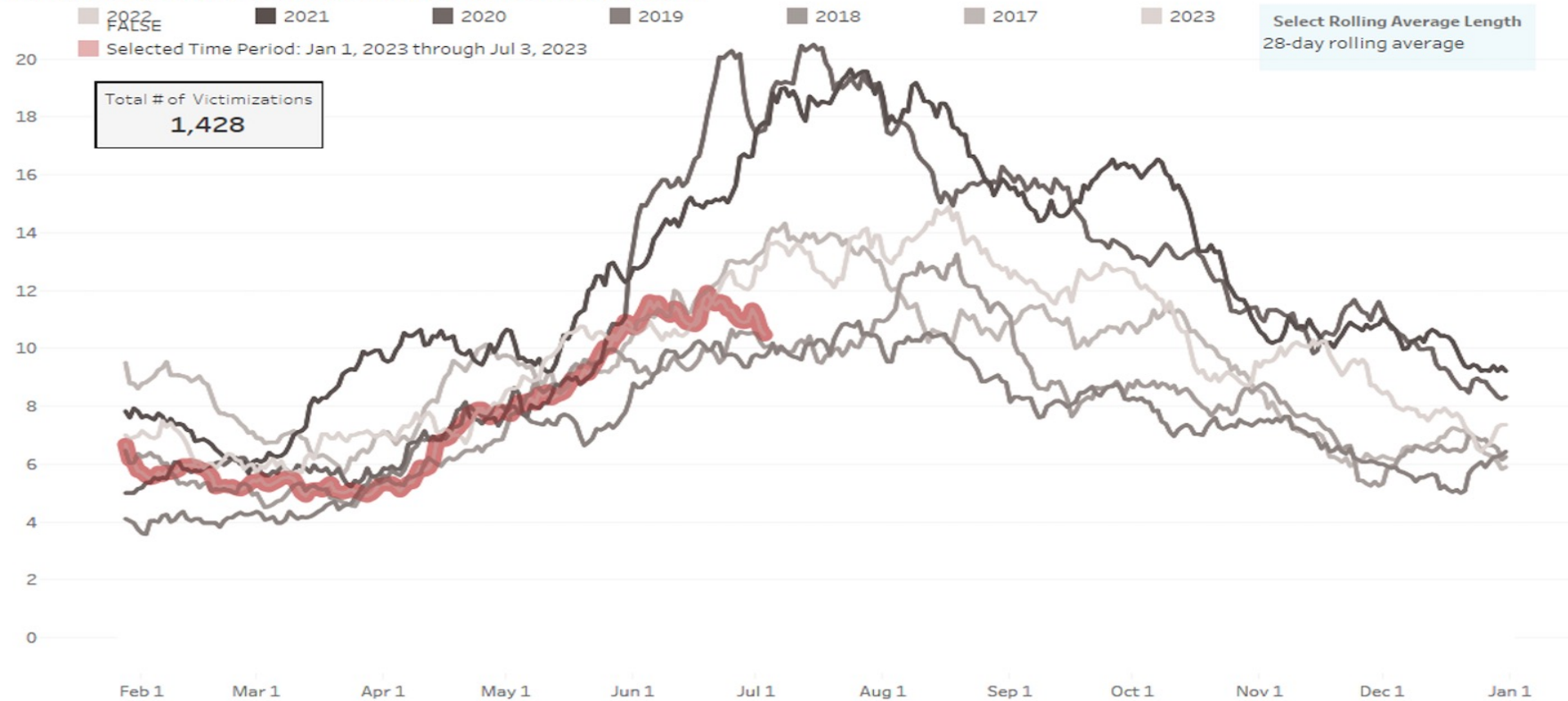

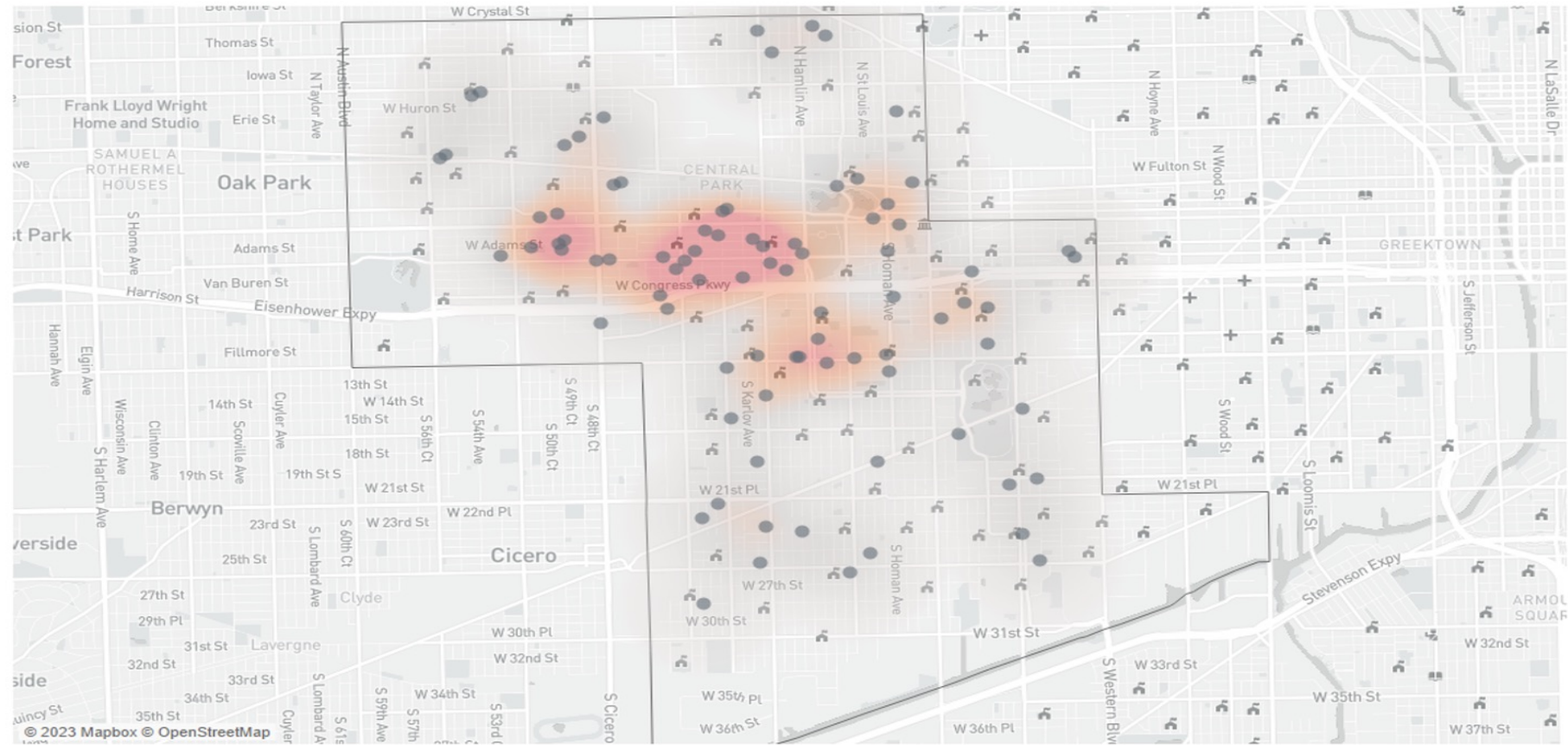
